

# Simple HTML Document

The following is a very simple (but complete) HTML document:

```
<html>
<head>
<title>
This is the title
</title>
</head>
<body>
<h1>
Section header #1
</h1>
<p>
Finally, some text.
</p>
</body>
</html>
```

Enter this HTML into a text document (using a text editor – not a word processor!). Save the file with a “.html” extension (e.g., “index.html”).

Note how the tags are nested:

```
<html>
  <head>
    <title>
      This is the title
    </title>
  </head>
  <body>
    <h1>
      Section header #1
    </h1>
    <p>
      Finally, some text.
    </p>
  </body>
</html>
```

The tags define the document structure. The <html> tag contains a <head> and a <body>. The <head> contains the <title> and the <body> contains the content – in this case, a section header <h1> and a single paragraph <p>.
